# The use of program clarification in program development

### Overview

Program clarification is applied to assess a program's plausibility in achieving its intended program outcomes. It is a useful process that can be conducted at the policy and service levels during program development.

In the seminar, Jenny will present a case study on program clarification that she conducted with policy and service levels managers in a community health organisation. The seminar will focus on the steps and methods used in program clarification and will include introduction to the development of a program implementation and monitoring plan using the program logic table format.
