### **Suggested goal and objectives**

#### **Objectives:**

Over the next 12 months, the Evaluation Interest Group will work towards the following:

1. Enhance capacity of members in monitoring and evaluation practice through regular access to evaluation resources (peers, meetings, including the Australasian Evaluation Society [AES] resources).
2. Increase awareness and application of ethics and standards in evaluation practice through increased access to evaluation resources.
3. Act as an advocate for evaluation and its utilization for learning in the workplace.
4. Submit one best practice evaluation from Tasmania to the yearly AES Awards (see attachment 2).
