Overview

There has been increasing interest in evaluation and logic models in the last two decades. The first part of the seminar will introduce Program Logic from a theoretical perspective. Different examples of logic models used in teaching will be explained, focusing on the three steps process, coined the ATM approach to logic modelling.

Practical application of Program Logic used in real-case scenario will be explained in the second part of the seminar. Examples on how this style of analysis can be utilized in different program evaluation will be discussed.

At the end of the seminar, you will be able to adapt the ATM approach to meet your individual needs as well as build on the practical, hands-on approach being used in real case scenario.
